## Final facts

The seven previous finals were won by European and South American sides, with UEFA representatives claiming the last four titles since 2007, and CONMEBOL clubs the first three.

Brazil has produced more FIFA Club World Cup-winning sides (three) than any other country, followed by Italy with two, and England and Spain with one apiece.

Of the past seven finals, one was decided on penalties (Corinthians-Vasco da Gama in 2000) and one was settled in extra time (Estudiantes la Plata-Barcelona in 2009).

The average number of goals scored per final is just over two (2.14). The highest-scoring title decider was AC Milan's 4-2 win over Boca Juniors in 2007, while only one finished 0-0, namely the 2000 showpiece between Corinthians and Vasco da Gama. The biggest winning margin was Inter Milan's 3-0 victory over Mazembe Englebert in 2010.

Ravshan Irmatov is officiating his second FIFA Club World Cup final, having already taken charge of the 2008 decider between Manchester United and Liga Deportiva Universitaria de Quito, which ended 1-0 in favour of the Red Devils. The Uzbek referee thus equals the record of Mexico's Benito Archundia, who oversaw the 2005 and 2009 finals.
