* The Golden Goal rule was introduced in 1993 and abolished on 1 July 2004. Since then, if a match is tied, it is followed by extra-time, consisting of two periods of 15 minutes each. If the match is still tied after extra-time, a decisive penalty shoot-out is carried out.

Hat tricks (1991-2003)

Modern meaning of the term 'hat trick': a player scoring three goals in a match. In Britain at least, a hat trick simply means three goals in a game.
