



FIFA World Cup Stadium Bielefeld – Arrival by public transport

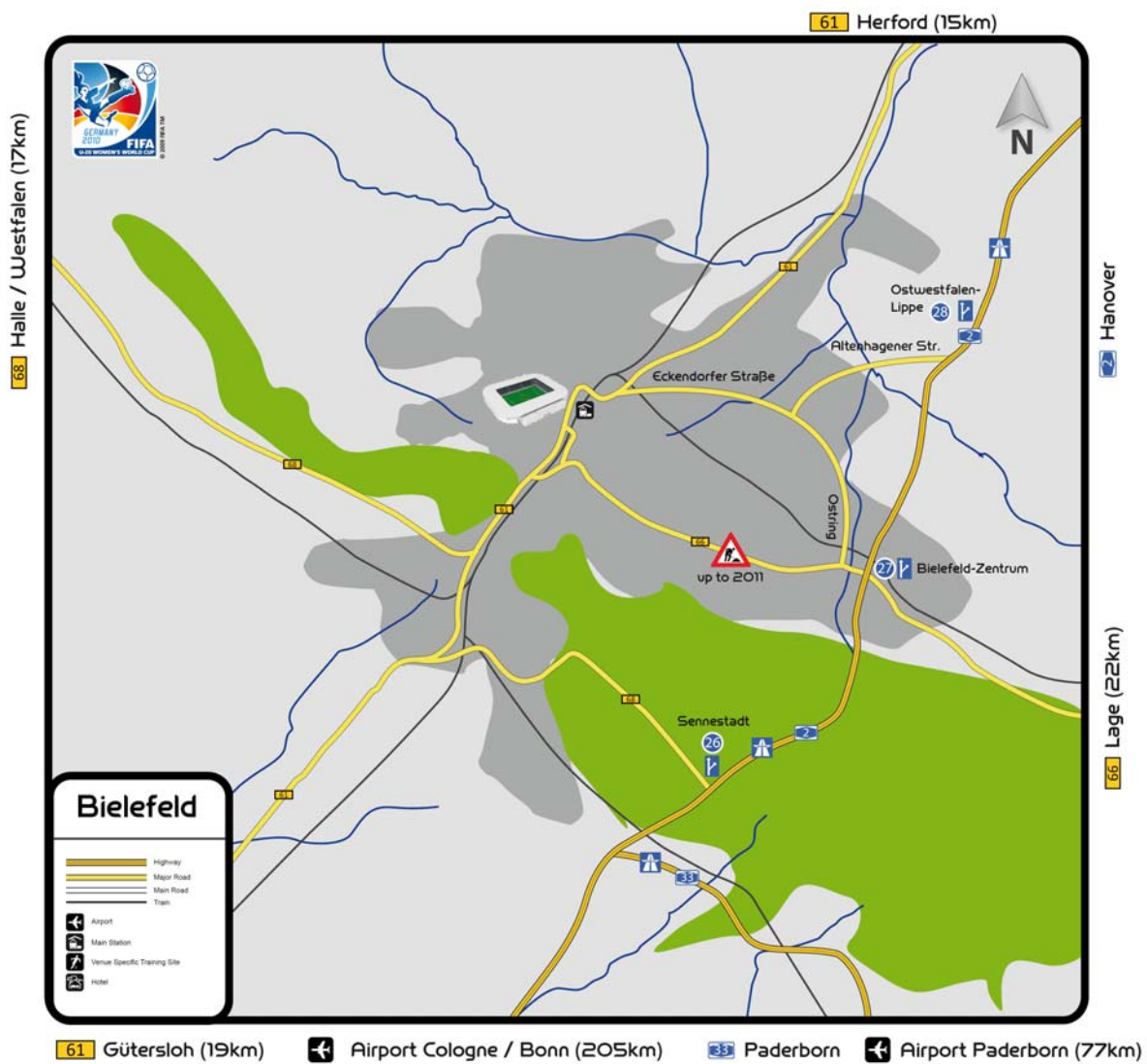
After a short foot path from the main train station (see signs to Stadtbahn [light rail]) line 4 towards Lohmannshof leads directly to the FIFA World Cup Stadium Bielefeld. Please get off after 2 stops at the stop "Rudolf-Oetker-Halle." After 300 m on foot you will reach the FIFA World Cup Stadium Bielefeld. Use of the light rail train is free of charge for FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup Germany 2010 ticket holders.

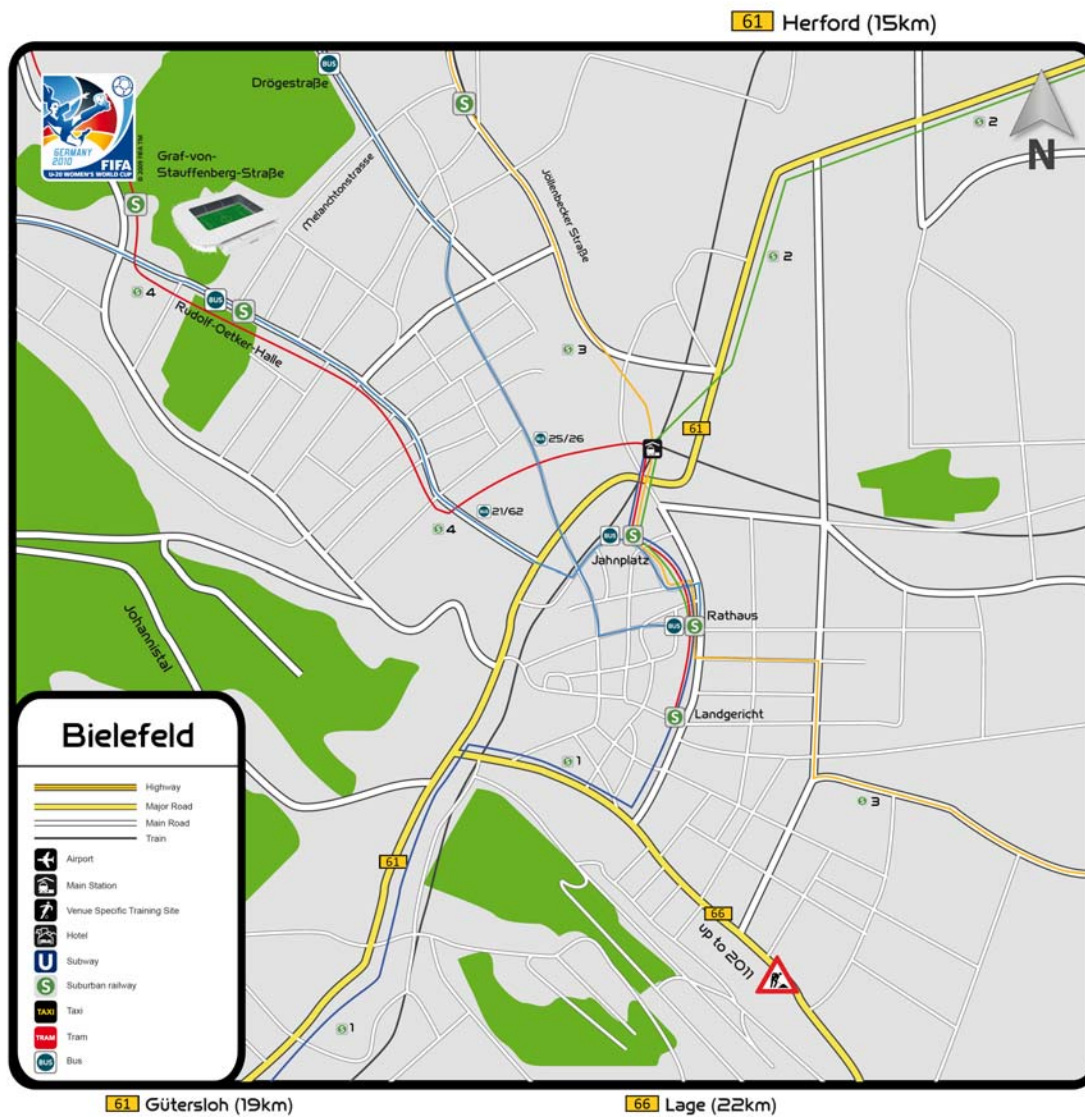
From the parking lots at the university, line 4 towards Rathaus [city hall] leads to the stop "Rudolf-Oetker-Halle" after 2 stops. You will reach the FIFA World Cup Stadium Bielefeld after 300 m on foot from here.

Travellers coming from the south may also board at the end station "Senne." From there line 1 towards Schildesche goes to Jahnplatz. There please transfer to line 4 towards Lohmannshof. Get off at Rudolf-Oetker-Halle after 3 stops. If needed, special trains going directly to the FIFA World Cup Stadium Bielefeld as line 4 will be employed.

The above routes are accessible and therefore also suitable for physically-challenged persons.

All light rail lines run parallel at the stops "Hauptbahnhof" [main train station], "Jahnplatz" and "Rathaus" [city hall]. From there other destinations in Bielefeld can be reached through the radial light rail network.
