

FIFA World Cup™: seeded teams 1930-2010

South Africa 2010

For sporting reasons the FIFA Organising Committee based the criteria to determine the seeding on the October 2009 FIFA/Coca-Cola World Ranking rather than the November edition. In particular, the European Zone, where the play-offs involving the eight best runners-up led to an imbalance in the number of qualification matches played between the teams.

There were no official seeds for this World Cup. Geographical "sections" were formed from which the four groups were drawn.
